You may choose to bequest a percentage of your estate or the residual, which ensures that no beneficiary is disadvantaged if the value of the estate changes over time.

Please let the Club know if you include a gift in your will so that we can thank you. We will also respect your decision should you will to join anonymously and will ensure confidentiality of your bequest.

How to make a bequest

Making a bequest is a simple and inexpensive process

You can change your will, in consultation with your family and lawyer, or simply add a codicil to an existing will at no cost. You can define the extent of your bequest in one of four ways:

1

Whole estate

This may occur when an individual does not have any beneficiaries

2

Percentage

A percentage of the total value of your estate

3

Residuary

The residue of your estate after taking care of all your other beneficiaries

4

Specific

A fixed amount of money or proceeds from the sale of certain assets such as life insurance

We recommend you use the following wording when including the South Fremantle Football Club in your will:

I bequeath [the whole/a percentage/residuary/something specific] of my estate to the South Fremantle Football Club (ABN: 62 379 082 609) for purposes that it shall determine, and this bequest will be free from all duties.

The receipt of an authorised officer of the South Fremantle Football Club will be sufficient discharge to my Executor/Trustee.
